RULES & REGULATIONS

All patrons are required to abide by the following rules at all times:

- Always represent Casino Del Sol (CDS) and Wild Wild West Steampunk Convention 11 (WWWC) in a professional and courteous manner.
- · No abusive or foul language.
- · No fighting.
- · No loitering.
- No possession or consumption of any drugs (including medical and recreational marijuana which are also illegal on tribal land).
- · No lewd or lascivious behavior.
- · Only service animals are permitted.
- No modification of any Casino Del Sol structure or posting anything on the walls.
- · No masks which impair vision.
- No guns which use explosives to fire, per tribal law, including Single Action Shooting Society (S.A.S.S.).
- Blades that exceed 4 inches long are illegal on tribal land. (Exception is any blades purchased in the vendor hall which must be immediately transported to your vehicle upon purchase - not kept in your room.)
- All weapons will be inspected by WWWC security upon entry.
- Touch of any persons or personal property shall be done with consent only.

Attendees may be removed from the premises, without compensation or refund, for violations of WWWC or CDS rules and regulations. Security personnel from WWWC and CDS have the authority to enforce all rules.






Meet & Greet: Wheeler "Doc" Stone




